1. \_\_\_canker sore\_\_\_\_\_ - informal name for aptheous mouth ulcer.
2. \_\_\_recurring\_\_\_\_\_ - an illness/ condition which keeps coming back.
3. \_\_\_ulcer\_\_\_\_\_ - a break in skin or mucous membrane with loss of surface tissue, disintegration and necrosis of epithelial tissue, and often pus.
4. \_\_\_RAS\_\_\_\_\_ - is a common condition, restricted to the mouth, that typically starts in childhood or adolescence as recurrent small, round, or ovoid ulcers with circumscribed margins, erythematous haloes, and yellow or gray floors.
5. \_\_\_discharge\_\_\_\_\_ - the flow of fluid from part of the body.
6. \_\_\_lesion\_\_\_\_\_ - an injury; hurt; wound.
7. \_\_\_aphthae majores\_\_\_\_\_ - a severe form of aphthae characterized by large numerous, frequently occurring ulcers that may take up to six weeks to heal.
8. \_\_\_bening\_\_\_\_\_ - not melignant, self-limiting
